## 5. Executive Officer Update and Scrutiny

**JDH** 

JDH Outlined the projects they had undertaken since the last meeting, as summarised helow:

- Preparation of <u>DSU's stance on the government's ban on conversion therapy</u>.
- Planning work for <u>Women's History Month</u>. There will be efforts to highlight the stories of influential women, and an event will take place in the Zen Zone, hosted by the DSU Women's Liberation Officer.
- Attendance at numerous meetings with the University to represent students.
- Work on period poverty (Free the Flow) campaign.
- Campaigning for 'welfare boxes' to be placed around DSU.

Asked for opinions on the placement of sanitary products in male bathrooms (as well as female and gender-neutral ones) within DSU. The rationale for this was clarified by explaining that there are DMU students who are in the process of transitioning gender to male, but who still menstruate.

Those present thought that this was a good idea.

Asked for an update on the progress of this when possible / when relevant information becomes available.

Al (On the subject of welfare boxes) Raised the point that we shouldn't encourage over use of certain items, such as paracetamol. They also raised the concern that some people may take more than their fair share.

## 6. Zone Development Fund

JDH Mentioned that £250.00 was available as a development fund for the zone and suggested that this could be used to fund informal zone meetings / social events, giving members the chance to get to know one another better.
