- Increase student engagement and representation.

Discussion:

- AA: Word of mouth is powerful-students must inform each other.
- Twig: Society members aren't aware of voting members-training should include Council info.
- PC: Societies are unaware and need better communication-could be made mandatory.
- Suggestions:
 - Include in Course Rep catch-ups.
 - Use lecturers to share information.
 - \circ $\;$ Share updates on the Learning Zone.

Student Feedback:

- Students attended to make friends and learn about Council Café.
- Quorum discussion:
 - $\circ~$ Jas suggested reducing quorum to 15/18.
 - $\circ~$ HG advised against it to maintain democratic integrity.
 - $\circ~$ JO and others argued quorum reduction is needed to pass motions and enable change.

Ideas Raised:

- Encourage more diverse participation.
- Make Council engagement mandatory for societies and sports clubs.
- Use LinkedIn and email to reach students outside of social media.
- Introduce incentives (e.g., point system or awards) or light penalties (e.g., strikes for non-attendance).

Concerns:

- Need for better regulation and response within societies.
- Reports of negative experiences due to poor society leadership.
